Notification

Jammu, the 25th March, 2022.

S.O.-127.ô Whereas, on 20-01-2018, SPO Mohd Yaseen No. 1292/SPO posted in Police Station, Marwah deserted the Police Station along with one AK-47 rifle issued to Constable Mushtaq Ahmad No. 561/Ktr of Police Station, Marwah to join the terrorist outfit with intention to threat unity, integrity and sovereignty of country; and

2. Whereas, upon this information, a Case FIR No. 01/2018 under sections 379, 120-B, 121, IPC, 7/25 Arms Act was registered in Police

- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and recorded the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, the deserted SPO, Mohd Yaseen was arrested along with his associate namely Reyaz Ahmad Khanday S/o Ab. Gaffar Khanday R/o Methwan from a hideout in Village Kethpeth and during search Police recovered stolen AK-47 rifle along with magazine, 30 rounds from the possession of the said accused SPO and also recovered one 12 Bore round, 02 blanket, 01 Axe, 01 ammunition pouch from the hideout; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation, the accused SPO disclosed that the other persons namely (1) Ab. Rashid Tak S/o Gh. Rasool Tak R/o Kethpeth (2) Constable Yassir Bahadur S/o Bahadur Wani R/o Kethpeth and (3) Ab. Gani @ Gani Wagra S/o Ali Bhat R/o Nabar, Marwah were involved in the commission of offence and helped the accused in escaping from the Police Station along with the AK-47 rifle. Subsequently all the three accused were arrested in connection with the case; and
- 6. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused SPO, Mohammad Yaseen and Constable, Yassir Bhadur have committed breach of their official duties and in a well knit criminal conspiracy with other accused stole arms/ammunition from Police Station with intention to commit terrorist act; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for

- 4. Ab. Rashid Tak S/o Gh. Rasool Tak R/o Kethpeth, Marwah.
- 5. Ab. Gani @ Gani Wagra S/o Ali Bhat R/o Nabar, Marwah.
- 8. Whereas, the accused Ab. Gani @ Gani Wagra is absconding and proceedings under section 299 Cr. PC is proposed to be initiated against him; and
- 9. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.
- 11. Whereas, the Government has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused under the aforementioned provision of the

- 12. Whereas, the Government is also of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the other accused Police personnel for according sanction as required under section 5 of the PEPO for their prosecution under section 3 of PEPO and section 30 of the Police Act.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and section 196 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, and section 5 of the Police Enhanced Penalty Ordinance Smvt., 2005, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused for the commission of offences punishable under relevant section as indicated in para (7) above arising out of FIR No. 01/2018 of Police Station, Marwah.
