Notification

Jammu, the 29th March, 2022.

S.O.-137. Whereas, on 30-3-2018, Police Station, Awantipora received a docket to the effect that Police Component Awantipora laid a Naka at Padgampora bridge and during Naka checking, Police intercepted a person who tried to escape but was chased down on spot and identified

as Rafiq Ahmad Dar S/o Gh. Hassan R/o Ghat Tokuna, Awantipora. During
search of the bag carried by the said person, Police recovered one Chinese
hand grenade from the said bag ; and

2. Whereas, upon the information, a case FIR No. 50/2018 under
sections 18, 20, 21 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevntion) Act, 1967, came
to be registered in Police Station, Awantipora and investigation, of the
case was set into motion. Subsequently, during investigation, section 23
ULA(P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during investigation, one more accused namely, Abid
Majeed Sheikh S/o Ab. Majeed Sheikh R/o Dadsura Tral was arested in
connection with the case and on his discloser, Police recovered an
amount of Rs. 5,37,000/- from his instances which were provided to him
by terrorist of Ansar-Gazwatul-Hind outfit Zakir Rashid Bhat @ Zakir
Musa S/o Ab. Rashid Bhat R/o Noorpora, Tral for purchase of arms/
ammunition ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, site plan of place of occurrence
and seizure memos were prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted
with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the
relevant provisions of law ; and

5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that both the
accused Rafiq Ahmad Dar and Abid Majeed Sheikh in a well knit
criminal conspiracy with terrorist Zakir Rashid Bhat @ Zakir Musa
procured arms/ammunition with the intention to commit terror act ; and

6. Whereas, accused terrorist Zakir Rashid Bhat has been killed in
an encounter with the security forces and proceeding under law shall abate
against him ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses
recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has
established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for their prosecution under the aforesaid provisions of Law.

Now, therefore, in the exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused viz. Rafiq Ahmad Dar and Abid Majeed Sheikh for the commission of offence punishable under relevant sections the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as indicated against each accused at Para (7), arising out of FIR No. 50/2018 of Police Station, Awantipora.
