Jammu, the 5th April, 2022.

SO-153.ôôWhereas, on 10-10-2021, a tip-off was received by Police Station, Gandhi Nagar to the effect that a person was roaming in Gandhi Nagar area, taking photographs and video clips of vital installations and crowded business establishments. The Police party rushed to the spot

and apprehended said person from Gole Market, Gandhi Nagar, Jammu  
who was identified as Mohammad Anas S/o Mohammad Saleem R/o  
Mutiyapora, Bazarpati, UP ; and

2. Whereas, upon the information, a Case FIR No. 278/2021 under  
sections 120-B, 121 IPC, 18, 20, 23, 38, 39 of ULA (P) Act, came  
to be registered in Police Station, Gandhi Nagar and investigation, was  
taken up. Subsequently, during investigation section 120-B IPC, was  
dropped from the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place  
of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of  
witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were  
recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused  
Mohammad Anas was in contact with one Sehran Nawaz Sheikh S/o  
Gh. Abass R/o Malapith, Kishtwar, who motivated him to take  
photographs/video clips of vital installations and send to PAK handler  
Hamid and Jammal Khan. Subsequently, accused Sehran Nawaz Sheikh  
was arrested in connection with the case. The investigation in respect  
of PAK handlers shall remain continue to bring out their role in the  
case ; and

5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses  
recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has  
established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused in the  
commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each  
of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 and IPC ;ô

6. Whereas, the Government has independently examined the Case  
Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and  
has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against  
the above accused under 121 Indian Penal Code ; and

7. Whereas, on further perusal the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967.
