7. Whereas, accused Nisar Ahmad Khanday is absconding being active terrorist and proceedings under section 299 Cr. PC. are proposed to be initiated against him ; and

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz Nisar Ahmad Khanday, Muzaffar Ahmad Malik, Mohammad Iqbal Malik and Zahid Ahmad Tantray for the commission of offences punishable under relevant sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, indicated against each at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 95/2018 of Police Station, Dooru.
