Jammu, the 7th April, 2022.

SO-157.ôôWhereas, on 08-7-2017, Police Station, Ganderbal received reliable information to the effect that one person namely Naseer Ahmad Dar S/o Late Gh. Mohammad Dar R/o Buderkund along with his unknown accomplice was pasting posters of dreaded slain militant on

the shutters of shops and electric poles on his first death anniversary
at Buderkund, Ganderbal, in order to instigate the general public of the
area to commit unlawful activities and to disrupt sovereignty and territorial
integrity of the nation ; and

2. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 138/2017 under Section 13 Unlawful
Activities (Prevention) Act 1967, came to be registered in Police Station,
Ganderbal and investigation was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place
of occurrence and seizure memo was prepared and statement of witnesses
acquainted with the facts and circumstance of the case were recorded
under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, the accused viz. Naseer Ahmad
Dar was arrested and during his personal search some incriminating
material was recovered from his possession ; and

5. Whereas, during further investigation, it was established that the
accused was pasting the posters of killed terrorist Burhan Wani on the
shops and electrical poles in the area in order to provoke the general
public to commit unlawful activities and to disrupt sovereignty and
territorial integrity of the nation ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses
recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has
established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for
the commission of offence punishable under section as shown against
his name of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :

6. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under
sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)
Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the
other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to a

 conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the
 accused ; and

7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of the Section of 45 ULA (P) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for his prosecution under the aforesaid provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused viz. Naseer Ahmad Dar for the commission of offence punishable under Section 13 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 138/2017 of Police Station, Ganderbal.
