SO-158.óóWhereas, on 19-07-2016, Police Station, Srigufwara received reliable information that one person Shabir Ahmad Parray @ Mufti S/o Mohammad Abdullah Parray R/o Khiram addressed a public 2. Whereas, upon this information, a Case FIR No. 44/2016 under Section 13 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act 1967, came to be registered in Police Station, Srigufwara and investigation was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that on the date of occurrence accused Bashir Ahmad Nengroo and one more accused Shabir Ahmad Parray S/o Mohammad Abdullah Parray R/o Khiram raised anti national slogans while addressing the public gathering at Village Sirhama, thereby instigated the public against the unity, integrity and sovereignty of India ; and

5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of offence punishable under section as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :ô

S. Name of accused Offence No.

- 1. Bashir Ahmad Nengroo @ Habble13 ULA (P) ActS/o Gh. Rasool R/o Sirhama.
- Shabir Ahmad Parray @ Mufti Shabir S/o Mohammad Abdullah Parray R/o Khiram.

6. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to a conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the accused ; and

7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of the Section of 45 of ULA (P) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for their prosecution under the aforesaid provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused viz. Bashir Ahmad Nengroo @ Habble and Shabir Ahmad Parray @ Mufti Shabir for the commission of offence punishable under Section 13 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 44/2016 of Police Station, Srigufwara.
