## Notification

Jammu, the 7th April, 2022.

SO-161.66Whereas, on 27-12-2021, a tip-off was received by Police Station, Chadoora regarding presence of terrorists in Village Hayatpora, who are trying to carry out terrorist activities in the area. Accordingly, joint cordon search operation launched in the village and during search

 Police/Security forces intercepted a vehicle. On carrying out search of the said vehicle, 04 persons were boarded in the vehicle. During questioning the said persons disclosed their names viz. Mohammad Altaf Bhat S/o Gh. Hassan Bhat R/o Qazipora, Chadoora, Shabir Ahmad Bhat S/o Gh. Nabi Bhat R/o Khigam, Pulwama, Jamsheed Ahmad Magray S/o Ab. Hamid Magray R/o Rajpora, Pulwama and Zahid Rashid Dar S/o Ab. Rashid Dar R/o Poutrigam, Pulwama. During their search Police recovered arms/ammunition and other incriminating material from them ; and

2. Whereas, upon the information, a Case FIR No. 242/2020 under Sections 18, 19, 20, 23, 38 ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Chadoora and investigation, was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation Section 19 ULA (P) Act, was dropped from the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused Mohammad Altaf Bhat who was working as SPO in CIU Camp, Chadoora and has deserted alongwith arms/ammunition and joined the JeM terrorist banned outfit and other accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Bhat, Jamsheed Ahmad Magray and Zahid Rashid Dar were associates of the JeM outfit with intention to further its activities ; and

5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established prima facie involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :ô

Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused ; and

7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohammad Altaf Bhat, Shabir Ahmad Bhat, Jamsheed Ahmad Magray and Zahid Rashid Dar for the commission of offences punishable under relevant sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, indicates against each at Para (5) above, arising out of FIR No. 242/2020 of Police Station, Chadoora.
