SO-163.66Whereas, on 04-05-2020, Police Station, Sheeri received a docket to the effect that while performing Naka checking Police along with other security personnel, the Naka party found one person coming from Sheeri towards Gantamulla. On noticing the presence of security

forces, the said person tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended
who was identified later as Umar Mushtaq Khan S/o Mushtaq Ahmad
Khan R/o Firdous-Abad Batmaloo, Srinagar and from his personal search
one live Hand Grenade, 113 live rounds of AK-47, 02 Mobile Phones,
one identity card, driving license and one Pan Card were recovered from
his possession ; and

2. Whereas, upon this information, Case FIR No. 18/2020 under
Section 7/27 Arms Act, 13, ULA(P) Act, came to be registered in Police
Station, Sheeri, and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently,
during the investigation Sections 20, 23 ULAP(P) Act were added in
the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, site plan of the
place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statements
of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case
were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that accused
viz. Umar Mushtaq Khan was a member of LeT banned outfit and the
accused had procured the anus/ammunition from unknown terrorists of
the said organization for the commission of unlawful activities in the
area ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses
recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has
established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused of the
commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each
of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :ô

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-
section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)
Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the
other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the
conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant
documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority

appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities
(Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is
sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for
prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-
section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)
Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching
prosecution against the accused viz. Umar Mushtaq Khan for the
commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 20 and 23 of
the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR
No. 18/2020 of Police Station, Sheeri.
