Jammu, the 13th April, 2022.

SO-169.ôôWhereas, on 21-10-2021, Police Station, Sheeri received a docket to the effect that a joint Naka was established by Police/Security forces at Kitchama Crossing, Sheeri. During checking, a person on seeing the Naka party tried to escape but was chased down on spot and identified

as Farooq Ahmad Malik S/o Gh. Mohammad Malik R/o Kitchama. During  
his personal search, Police recovered 01 Chinese grenade, 02 Pistol  
Magazines and 16 rounds from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, Case FIR No. 59/2021 under  
section 7/25 Arms Act, 20, 39 ULA(P) Act, came to be registered in  
Police Station, Sheeri and investigation of the case was taken up.  
Subsequently, during investigation, section 20 ULA (P) Act was dropped  
and section 23 ULA (P) was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, site plan of the  
place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statements  
of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case  
were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused  
viz. Farooq Ahmad Malik was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW)  
for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit and was providing logistic support  
to them, besides, procured the said grenade/ammunition from active  
terrorist namely, Hilal Ahmad Sheikh S/o Ab. Hamid Sheikh R/o  
Shrakwara in order to promote terrorist activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, the investigation in respect of the active terrorist Hilal  
Ahmad Sheikh shall continue to bring out his role in the case ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses  
recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has  
established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for  
the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against  
his name of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :ô

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-  
section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)  
Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the

other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the  
conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Farooq Ahmad Malik for the commission of offences punishable under sections 23 and 39 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 59/2021 of Police Station, Sheeri.
