Jammu, the 20th April, 2022.

S.O.-192.ô Whereas, on 12-10-2018, Police Station, Baramulla received a docket to the effect that during Naka Checking at Stadium Colony, Janbazpora, Baramulla, Police arrested four persons namely (1) Mudasir Ahmad Sheergojri S/o Jalal-ud-Din (2) Imtiyaz Ahmad Wani S/o Mohammad Ayoub both residents of Tumlahal, Pulwama (3) Jahangir Ahmad Bhat S/o Ghulam Hassan R/o Panjran, Pulwama (4) Bashir Ahmad Malik S/o Ghulam Ahmad Malik R/o Panjran, Pulwama who were proceeding to Lolab, Kupwara in view of call given by Hurriyat on the

- 2. Whereas, upon this information, Case FIR No. 170/2018 under section 13 of ULA(P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Baramulla and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation section 39 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of the place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law and accused were arrested in the case; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mudasir Ahmad Sheergojri, Imtiyaz Ahmad Wani, Jahangir Ahmad Bhat and Bashir Ahmad Malik were working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for HM banned outfit and raised anti-national slogans and unfurled Pakistani flag in order to breach the peace and tranquility of the area and challenged the integrity and territorial sovereignty of the Nation; and
- 5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô
- - Mudasir Ahmad Sheergojri
 S/o Jalal-ud-Din R/o Tumlahal, Pulwama.
 ULA(P) Act
 - 2. Imtiyaz Ahmad Wani S/o Mohammad Ayoub R/o Tumlahal, Pulwama.
 - 3. Jahangir Ahmad Bhat S/o Ghulam Hassan R/o Panjran, Pulwama.
 - 4. Bashir Ahmad Malik S/o Ghulam Ahmad Malik R/o Panjran, Pulwama.

- 6. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevent documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused; and
- 7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for prosecution under the provisions of Law.

Now, therefore, in the exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mudasir Ahmad Sheergojri, Imtiyaz Ahmad Wani, Jahangir Ahmad Bhat and Bashir Ahmad Malik for the commission of offences punishable under sections 13 and 39 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 170/2018 of Police Station, Baramulla.
