

Notification

Jammu, the 20th April, 2022.

S.O.-193.ô Whereas, on 26-07-2020, Police Station, Karnah received docket from Major, 7 RR Camp Sadna Gali to the effect that joint team of Police/Security forces intercepted two vehicles for checking at Sadna Gali NC Pass and during checking Police/Security forces recovered 01 AK-56 rifle, 02 AK Magazines, 02 Pistols, 04 Pistols Magazines, 76 AK rounds, 90 Pistol rounds, 06 Chinese Grenades, 12 Plastic grenade, along with 10 Narcotic pocket etc. from both the vehicles and arrested its drivers identified as Ameer Ahmad Sheikh S/o Mohammad Amin Sheikh R/o Hajinar and Bashir Ahmad Sheikh S/o Gh. Ahmad R/o Dildar, Batpora, Karnah; and

- 2. Whereas, upon the information, a Case FIR No. 57/2020 under section 8/21 NDPS Act, 7/25 Arm Act, 13, 16, 18, 39 of ULA(P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Karnah and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation section 16 of ULA (P) Act was dropped from the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, site plan of the place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation two more accused viz. Zahoor Ahmad Mir S/o Gh. Rassol Mir R/o Mirgund, Baramulla and Zahoor Ahmad Shah S/o Syed Akbar Shah R/o Panjtara, Karnah were found involved in the case. Subsequently, both the accused were arrested in connection with the case and during investigation arms/ammunition viz. 01 Pistol with magazines, 08 Pistol rounds and 07 AK 47 rounds were recovered from their possession; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that accused viz. Bashir Ahmad Sheikh and Zahoor Ahmad Mir were in contact with two PoK handlers Molvi Saleem and Aquib Rasool and were working for them. Both the accused motivated other two accused Ameer Ahmad and Zahoor Ahmad Shah to work for the terrorists and under well knit criminal conspiracy all the accused procured arms/ammunition and Narco drugs from PoK handlers for further distribution among the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô



- 2. Bahir Ahmad Sheikh S/o Gh. Ahmad 13, 18, 39 of R/o Dildar, Batpora, Karnah. ULA (P) Act
- 3. Zahoor Ahmad Mir S/o Gh. Rasool Mir R/o Mirgund, Baramulla.
- 4. Zahoor Ahmad Shah S/o Syed Akbar Shah R/o Pangtara, Karnah.
- 7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevent documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused; and
- 8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for their prosecution under the provisions of Law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Ameer Ahmad Sheikh, Bashir Ahmad Sheikh, Zahoor Ahmad Mir and Zahoor Ahmad Shah for the commission of offences punishable under sections 13, 18 and 39 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 57/2020 of Police Station, Karnah.
