Notification

Jammu, the 20th April, 2022.

S.O.-196.ô Whereas, on 24-12-2020, a tip-off was received by Police Station, Awantipora regarding presence of terrorists of prescribed outfit

Al-Badr in Village Dadsara and Larmoh, Awantipora. Accordingly, joint
cordon and search operation was launched and during search four
persons namely, Showket Ahmad Dar S/o Gulzar Ahmad Dar, Abid Majeed
Sheikh S/o Ab. Majeed Sheikh Rs/o Dadsara, Yawar Aziz Dar S/o Ab. Aziz
Dar and Sajad Hussain Parray S/o Ab. Rehman Parray Rs/o Larmoh were
arrested and on their disclosure, Police recovered 01 AK-56 rifle, 01
Magazine, 28 AK rounds and 01 hand grenade from his instances ; and

2. Whereas, upon this information, a Case FIR No. 195/2020 under section 7/25 Arms Act, 16, 18, 20, 38 of ULA(P) Act, 1967, was registered in Police Station, Awantipora and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation section 16 of ULA(P) Act was dropped and sections 23, 39 of ULA(P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, two more accused viz. Ab. Rehman Dar S/o Haji Sonaullah Dar R/o Larmoh and Gh. Rasool Bhat S/o Javid Huyder R/o Largam, Awantipora were found involved in the case. Subsequently, both the accused were arrested in connection with the case and on the disclosure of accused Gh. Rasool Bhat, Police recovered an amount of Rs. 2.60 lacs from his house ; and

5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused were in contact with one terrorist of Al-Badr banned outfit namely Umar Ali Mir S/o Ali Mohammad Mir R/o Dadsara who provided an amount of Rs. 2.60 lacs to the accused for purchase of arms/ammunition for the Al-Badr outfit. The accused were providing shelter/logistic support to the above terrorist for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, accused terrorist Umer Ali Mir has been killed in an encounter and proceedings under law would abate against him ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused in

Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of Law.

Now, therefore, in the exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Showkat Ahmad Dar, Abid Majeed Sheikh, Yawar Aziz Dar, Sajad Hussain Parray, Abdul
