Jammu, the 20th April, 2022.

- S.O.-198.ô Whereas, on 10-09-2020, Police Station, Dooru received a docket to the effect that a person namely, Yasir Ahmad Wani S/o Ab. Rehman Wani R/o Check Wangund, Dooru who went missing from his home on 06-09-2020 has joined the terrorist ranks of TRF outfit; and
- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 104/2020 under section 38 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Dooru and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation, section 19, 20, 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and

- 3. Whereas, during investigation, statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law and during investigation, three persons viz. Zahid Ahmad Tantray S/o Mohammad Sultan R/o Ringmandoo, Dooru, Irshad Ahmad Chopan S/o Gh. Nabi R/o Kokagund, Verinag and Shafiqullah Wani S/o Sadiq Hussain R/o Root-Fityana, Doda, were found working with the terrorists of LeT banned organization. Subsequently, the above accused were arrested in the case; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Yasir Ahmad Wani is member of TRF outfit (offshoot of LeT banned outfit) and other accused viz. Zahid Ahmad Tantray, Irshad Ahmad Chopan and Shafiqullah Wani were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the above terrorist and were providing logistic support to him, besides, under well knit criminal conspiracy were voluntarily harbouring the terrorist for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô

- 7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for their prosecution under the provisions of Law.

Now, therefore, in the exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Yasir Ahmad Wani, Zahid Ahmad Tantray, Irshad Ahmad Chopan and Shafiqullah Wani for the commission of offences punishable under relevant sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, indicates against each at para (06) above, arising out of FIR No. 104/2020 of Police Station, Dooru.
