Jammu, the 3rd January, 2022.

SO-2.ô Whereas, on 11-07-2021, Jammu Police received reliable information that some Kashmir Valley based vehicles (trucks) were involved in transportation of illegal arms/ammunition and a truck bearing No. JK13E-0211 owned and driven by Muntazir Manzoor S/o Manzoor Ahmed Bhat R/o Prichoo, Pulwama continuously indulging in transportation of arms/ammunition from border area of Jammu to Valley. The arms/ammunition is being dropped by Pakistan by drones and used by active terrorists of valley to threaten the integrity and sovereignty of India and to wage war against Government ; and

2. Whereas, a case FIR No. 110/2021 under Sections 120-B, 121 IPC, 18, 20, 23 ULA (P) Act 3/4 Explosive Substances Act,7/25Arms Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Gangyal and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation, Section 20 ULA (P) Act was dropped and Section 39 ULA (P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during investigation, Police established special naka at Purmandal Morh for checking of vehicles and during checking Police intercepted the said truck which was onway to Valley. The driver of the truck tried to escape but was chased down on spot and during checking Police recovered 01 Pistol, 01 Pistol Magazine and 02 Chinese hand grenades from the said vehicle and arrested accused Muntazir Manzoor Bhat S/o Manzoor Ahmad R/o Prichoo, Pulwama ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, accused Muntazir Manzoor disclosed that he was in constant touch with a PoK based terrorist Abu Hamas through social media and on his directions he procured the said arms/ammunition from Samba area which were dripped by the said terrorist through drone for further distribution among the terrorists active in the valley; and

5. Whereas, during further investigation, three more accused persons Towseef Ahmad Shah S/o Gh. Mohammad R/o Heff Shermal, Shopian, Ijhar Khan S/o Intaja Khan R/o Mirdan Mohalla, Kandla Shamli, UP and Jahangir Ahmad Bhat S/o Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat R/o Bandzoo, Pulwama were found involved in the case. Subsequently, all the above three accused persons were arrested in connection with the case ; and

6. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused persons Muntazir Manzoor, Towseef Ahmad, Ijahar Khan and Jahangir Ahmad were into constant touch with PoK based terrorists Abu Hamas @ Mujahid through social media and were working as Over Ground workers (OGWs) for the obove terrorist, besides under well knit criminal conspiracy were facilitating the transportation of arms/ammunition for the terrorists from one place to another for carrying out the terrorist activities in the Valley and to wage war against the Government ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons

8. Whereas, the Government has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above acccused persons under the aforementioned provisions of IPC ; and

9. Whereas, on further perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused persons for their prosecution under the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 also.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 ULA (P) Act, 1967 and Section 196 Cr. PC., the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under sections 18, 23, 39 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and Section 121 IPC in the case FIR No. 110/2021 of Police Station, Gangyal.
