## Notification

Jammu, the 26th April, 2022.

SO-212.66Whereas, on 11-11-2021, Police Station, Ganderbal received a docket to the effect that a Naka was established by Police at National Highway Road Khan-Peth, Ganderbal. During Naka checking, a person who tried to lob grenade upon the Naka party was chased down on spot and identified as Arshid Ahmad Mir S/o Mohammad

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, case FIR No. 211/2021 under sections 13, 39 of ULA (P) Act, 7/25 Arms Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Ganderbal and investigation was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation section 23 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Arshid Ahmad Mir was in contact with one terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely, Mukhtar Ahmad Shah S/o Siraj Ahmad Shah R/o Sindbal, Ganderbal and was providing shelter/logistic support to him for carrying out the terrorist ativities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, accused terrorist Mukhtar Ahmad Shah has been killed in an encounter and proceedings under law would abate against him; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of offence punishable under section as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô

- 7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Arshid Ahmad Mir for the commission of offences punishable under sections 13, 23 and 39 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 211/2021 of Police Station, Ganderbal.
