SO-215.óóWhereas, on 26-06-2010, Police Station, Sumbal received a docket to the effect that persons namely, Assadullah Parray S/o Ab. Gani Parray, Mehraj-ud-Din Gojri S/o Gh. Qadir, Sarfaraz Parray S/o Mansoor Ahmad Parray, Bashir Ahmad Parray S/o Mohammad

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 166/2010 under section 13 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Sumbal and investigation of the case was taken up; and
- 3. Whereas, during investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that on the date of occurrence all the accused after conclusion of friday prayers gathered in Bazar Sumbal and raised anti national slogans against the country, thereby instigated the general public against the unity, security, integrity and sovereignty of the country; and
- 5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô
- - 1. Assadullah Parray S/o Ab. Gani Parray 13 of ULA (P) Act. R/o Hajin.
 - Mehraj-ud-Din Gojri S/o Gh. Qadir Gojri R/o Hajin.
 - Sarfaraz Parray S/o Mansoor Ahmad Parray R/o Hajin.

- 4. Bashir Ahmad Parray S/o Mohammad Maqbool Parray R/o Hajin.
- Showkat Ahmad Dar S/o Ali Mohammad Dar R/o Hajin.
- 6. Showkat Ahmad Hajam @ Hakeem S/o Gh. Mohammad Hajam R/o Hajin.
- 6. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused; and
- 7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Assadullah Parray, Mehraj-ud-Din Gojri, Sarfaraz Parray, Bashir Ahmad Parray, Showkat Ahmad Dar and Showkat Ahmad Hajam for the commission of offences punishable under section 13 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 166/2010 of Police Station, Sumbal.
