## Notification

Jammu, the 28th April, 2022.

SO-223ô Whereas, on 24-02-2020, Police Station, Kakapora received a reliable information that two persons namely, Aqib Maqbool Lone S/o Mohammad Maqbool Lone R/o Ratnipora and Naseer Ahmad Hurrah S/o Abdul Majeed Hurrah R/o Gulbough Kakapora were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of Al- Bader banned outfit, besides, were in possession of explosive material which they were intending to use for planting IED in Kakapora area; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, case FIR No.11/2020 U/Ss 13, 18, 20 ULA (P) Act, 4/5 Explosive Substances Act, was registered in

- 3. Whereas, during investigation, both the accused viz Aqib Maqbool Lone and Naseer Ahmad Hurrah were arrested in connection with the case and during investigation arms/ammunition viz 10 AK-47 rounds, 10 Detonators, 09 Gelatin sticks and 14 meter explosive wire were also recovered from their residential houses on their disclosure which was provided to them by active terrorist of Al-Badr banned outfit namely Arjumand Gulzar Dar S/o Gulzar Ahmad Dar R/o Kharbutpora Ratnipora; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that accused Arjumand Gulzar Dar is member of Al-Badr banned outfit and the other accused viz. Aqib Maqbool Lone and Naseer Ahmad Hurrah were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the said terrorist and were providing shelter/logistic support to him, besides, under well knit criminal conspiracy procured the said arms/ammunition from the above terrorist for carrying out the unlawful activities in the area: and
- 5, Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against each of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô

- 1. Aqib Maqbool Lone S/o Mohd. Maqbool Lone R/o Ratnipora, 13, 18, 23, 39
- 2. Naseer Ahmad Hurrah S/o Abdul Majeed ULA (P) Act Hurrah R/o Gulbough Kakapora Pulwama.
- Arjumand Gulzar Dar S/o Gulzar Ahmad
  Dar R/o Kharbatpora Ratnipora.
  ULA(P) Act
- 6. Whereas, accused Arjumand Gulzar Dar being active terrorist is absconding against whom proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC have been proposed to be initiated ; and
- 7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima*

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Aqib Maqbool Lone, Naseer Ahmad Hurrah and Arjumand Gulzar Dar for the commission of offences punishable under relevant sections of the ULA (P) Act, indicated against each at Para (05) above, arising out of FIR No. 11/2020 of Police Station, Kakapora,
