Notification

Srinagar, the 24th May, 2022.

SO-250.66 Whereas, on 25-11-2021, Police Station, Awantipora, received a written docket to the effect that a joint Naka was established by Police/Security Forces at Awantipora. During the Naka checking, two persons while seeing the Naka party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Muzamil Ayoub Bhat S/o Mohammad Ayoub Bhat and Suhail Manzoor Mohand S/o Manzoor Ahamd Mohand

were recovered from a bag carried by accused viz. Muzamil Ayoub
Bhat ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 194/2021 under
sections 7/25 Arms Act, 18, 38, 39 of ULA (P) Act and was registered
in Police Station, Awantipora and the investigation of the case was set
into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, sections 20 and 23
of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan
of the place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and the
statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of
the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused
viz. Muzamil Ayoub Bhat was in contact with a terrorist of HM banned
outfit namely Shahid Ahmad Rather S/o Gh. Ahmad Rather R/o Larve
Jagir, Tral, through the virtual mode and on the directions of said terrorist
both the accused viz. Muzamil Ayoub Bhat and Suhail Manzoor Mohand
procured ammunition from JVC, Srinagar, from an unknown person for
further distribution among the terrorists of the said outfit ; and

5. Whereas, during the further investigation, one more accused viz.
Nadeem Ahmad Mantoo S/o Late Gh. Rasool Mantoo R/o Chakoora,
Pulwama, was found involved in the case. Subsequently, the said accused
was arrested in connection with the case and it was found that the said
accused deposited an amount of Rs. 25500/- in the account of the accused
viz. Muzamil Ayoub Bhat on the directions of the terrorist namely Shahid
Ahmad Rather for procurement of ammunition from JVC, Srinagar, from
an unknown person ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the
accused viz. Muzamil Ayoub Bhat, Suhail Manzoor Mohand and Nadeem
Ahmad Mantoo were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for
the terrorist namely, Shahid Ahmad Rather and were providing logistic
support to him, besides, accused Muzamil Ayoub Bhat and Suhail
Manzoor Mohand under a well-knit criminal conspiracy were facilitating
the transportation of arms/ammunition for the terrorist Shahid Ahmad
Rather from one place to another ; and

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Muzamil Ayoub Bhat, Suhail Manzoor Mohand, Shahid Ahmad Rather and Nadeem Ahmad Mantoo for the commission of offences punishable under relevant sections of ULA (P) Act, indicated against each accused at para (7) above, arising out of FIR No. 194/2021 of Police Station, Awantipora.
