Srinagar, the 21st June, 2022.

SO-300.ôôWhereas, on 25-12-2015, a tip-off was received by Police Station, Srigufwara, to the effect that at Village Srihama, some miscreants are provoking youth to join the terrorist ranks and also instigating public against the security and territorial integrity of India ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 86/2015 under section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station,

 Srigufwara and the investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently,
 during the investigation, Section 39 of ULA (P) Act was added in the
 case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan
 of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and
 the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances
 of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, three persons namely Adil
 Ahmad Dar S/o Ab. Rashid Dar, Javaid Ahmad Bandro S/o Gh. Rasool
 Bandro and Mohd Yasin Bhat S/o Gh. Qadir Bhat Residents of Satkipora,
 Srigufwara, were found involved in the commission of offence.
 Subsequently, the accused were arrested in the case and during
 investigation, 12 Posters of HM banned outfit were recovered from their
 possession ; and

5. Whereas, during the further investigation, it was established that
 the accused viz. Adil Ahmad Dar, Javaid Ahmad Bandro and Mohd Yasin
 Bhat were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists
 of HM banned outfit and were providing logistic support to them, besides,
 on the date of occurrence raised anti national slogans, thereby instigated
 the general public against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of
 India ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of
 witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer
 has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned
 accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of
 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their
 name :

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Adil Ahmad Dar, Javaid Ahmad Bandro and Mohd Yasin Bhat for the commission of offences punishable under sections 13 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 86/2015 of Police Station, Srigufwara.
