Notification

Srinagar, the 21st of June, 2022.

S.O.6301. Whereas, on 06-09-2018, Police Station, Srigufwara, received an information to the effect that at Khiram, Srigufwara, some miscreants namely, Reyaz Ahmad Lone S/o Mohammad Sultan Lone, Tariq Ahmad Hajam S/o Abdul Rehman Hajam, Mohammad Iqbal Rather S/o Sonallah Rather, Gulzar Ahmad Bhat S/o Ghulam Mohammad Bhat, Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat S/o Abdul Rehman Bhat R/o Durpora, Khiram and Bilal Ahmad Lone S/o Abdul Aziz Lone R/o Bewoora, Srigufwara, with some nefarious designs were planning

some subversive activities in the residence of Shahid Ahmad Lone
S/o Ghulam Mohammad Lone R/o Durpora, Khiram and were preparing
incriminatory material, thereby causing threat to the sovereignty and
territorial integrity of India and to secede Jammu and Kashmir from
the Union of India ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 63/2018 under
section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Srigufwara
and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the
investigation, Section 39 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, all the seven accused viz.
Reyaz Ahmad Lone, Tariq Ahmad Hajam, Mohammad Iqbal Rather,
Gulzar Ahmad Bhat, Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat, Bilal Ahmad Lone and
Shahid Ahmad Lone were arrested in the case and during checking 03
Pakistani Flags with 40 posters of HM banned outfit were recovered
from the accused ; and

4. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, site plan of
place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statements
of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case
were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

5. Whereas, during the further investigation, two more accused
namely, Mushtaq Ahmad Shah S/o Gh. Nabi Shah R/o Katsoo,
Srigufwara and Ab. Hadi Reshi S/o Ab. Qayoom Reshi R/o Sakras,
Sirigufwara were also found involved in the commission of offence.
Subsequently, both the accused were arrested in the case and during
investigation, 11 posters of HM banned outfit were recovered from
them ; and

6. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the
accused viz. Reyaz Ahmad Lone, Tariq Ahmad Hajam, Mohammad
Iqbal Rather, Gulzar Ahmad Bhat, Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat, Bilal Ahmad
Lone and Shahid Ahmad Lone, Mushtaq Ahmad Shah and Ab. Hadi
Reshi were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists

 of HM banned outfit and were pasting posters of the said outfit in the area in order to spread terror among the general public besides, on the date of occurrence were planning to commit unlawful activities in the area ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :

8. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Reyaz Ahmad Lone, Tariq Ahmad Hajam, Mohammad Iqbal Rather, Gulzar Ahmad Bhat, Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat, Bilal Ahmad Lone and Shahid Ahmad Lone, Mushtaq Ahmad Shah and Ab. Hadi Reshi for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 63/2018 of Police Station, Srigufwara.
