SO-316.ôôWhereas, on 03-07-2009, a tip-off was received by Police Station, Kheer Bhawani that persons namely, Farooq Ahmad Rather S/o Ab. Ahad R/o Khurag, Noor Mohammad Parray S/o Ab. Ahad Parray R/o Hatbura, Mohammad Maqbool Sofi S/o Gh. Mohammad Sofi R/o Khurhama, Mohammad Ashraf Bhat S/o Mohammad Maqbool Bhat R/o Baroosa, Ab. Hamid Bhat S/o Ali Mohammad Bhat R/o Sehpora, Mohammad Rafiq Tantray S/o Gh. Mohammad Tantray R/o Safapora,

 crossed over to Pakistan Occupied Kashmir (POK) for obtaining illegal
 arms/ammunition training with the intention to carry out terror activities
 and to disrupt the sovereignty and territorial integrity of India ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 48/2009 under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Kheer Bhawani and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, Section 2/3 E&IMCO was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law and during investigation, one accused viz. Firdous Ahmad Sheikh had returned back via Nepal Border. Subsequently, the said accused was arrested in the case ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Farooq Ahmad Rather, Noor Mohammad Parray, Mohammad Maqbool Sofi, Mohammad Ashraf Bhat, Ab. Hameed Bhat, Mohammad Rafiq Tantray, Mohammad Ayoub Ganie, Khursheed Ahmad Ganie, Mohammad Ramzan Bhat, Firdous Ahmad Wani and Firdous Ahmad Sheikh had crossed the LoC for obtaining illegal arms/ammunition training to carry out terror activities in the Valley ; and

5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offence punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :ô

6. Whereas, the accused viz. Farooq Ahmad Rather, Noor Mohammad Parray, Mohammad Maqbool Sofi, Mohammad Ashraf Bhat, Ab. Hamid Bhat, Mohammad Rafiq Tantray, Mohammad Ayoub Ganie, Khursheed Ahmad Ganie, Mohammad Ramzan Bhat and Firdous Ahmad Wani are absconding against whom the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC have been proposed to be initiated ; and

7. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the

other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the
conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above
accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant
documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority
appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities
(Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is
sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned
accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-
Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)
Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching
prosecution against the accused viz. Farooq Ahmad Rather, Noor
Mohammad Parray, Mohammad Maqbool Sofi Mohammad Ashraf Bhat,
Ab. Hamid Bhat, Mohammad Rafiq Tantray, Mohammad Ayoub Ganie,
Khursheed Ahmad Ganie, Mohammad Ramzan Bhat, Firdous Ahmad
Wani and Firdous Ahmad Sheikh for the commission of offence
punishable under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of
FIR No. 48/2009 of Police Station, Kheer Bhawani.
