S.O.-328.6 Whereas, on 24-08-2009, the Police Post, Hajin received an information to the effect that a person namely, Showkat Ahmad Hajam @ Hakeem, District President Muslim League, J&K S/o Gh. Mohammad Hajam R/o Paribal, Hajin, boarded on a vehicle along with his associates appeared at Village Markundal, and raised anti national slogans through mike/loud speaker, resulting in the gathering of large number of people on the spot, besides, pasted posters on the walls, thereby intended to disrupt sovereignty and territorial integrity of India ; and

7. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of Law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Showkat Ahmad Hajam @ Hakeem, (District President), Bashir Ahmad Parray, Umar Rasool Mir and Ab. Rashid Bhat, for the commission of offence punishable under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 162/2009 of Police Station, Sumbal.
