Notification

Srinagar, the 14th July, 2022.

S.O.-335. Whereas, on 15-11-2021, the Police Station, Sadder received a written report from Army 02 RR, Camp Zainakote, to the effect that an information was received about the hiding of some terrorists in a building near Classic Hospital, Hyderpora, planning to carry out terrorist attack, upon which, a Joint Search Operation was launched in the area. During the Search Operation, the hiding terrorists fired indiscriminately upon the Search Party with their illegally equipped arms/ammunition with the intention to kill them. The fire was retaliated and in the ensuing encounter, 02 terrorists and 02 terrorist associates were killed. During the search, the arms/ammunition viz. 02 Pistols, 04 Pistol Magazines and 08 Rounds were recovered from the encounter site ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that on 15-11-2021, the accused viz. Dr. Mudasir Gul, was killed by the terrorist namely, Aamir Latief Magray and Bilal Bhai @ Hyder @ Saklain, at the attic of the said rented building before their elimination and the deceased building owner namely, Mohammad Altaf Bhat, got killed during crossing fire at the exit point of the building when the hiding terrorists Aamir Latief Magray and Bilal Bhai @ Hyder @ Saklain, tried to escape from the encounter site ; and

7. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Aamir Latief Magray and Bilal Bhai @ Hyder @ Saklain, were members of the LeT banned outfit and the other accused viz. Mudasar Mehraj Khan and Dr. Mudasar Gul, under a well knit criminal conspiracy voluntarily harboured/concealed the said terrorist in the rented building and facilitated the said terrorist for carrying out the terrorist activities in the Srinagar City ; and

8. Whereas, the accused namely Aamir Latief Magray, Bilal Bhai @ Hyder @ Saklain and Dr. Mudasir Gul, got killed in the said encounter and the proceedings under law would abate against them ; and

9. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his namee :ô

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority

appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities
(Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient
material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for
his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by
Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)
Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution
against the accused viz. Mudasir Mehraj Khan, for the commission of
offences punishable under Sections 13, 18 and 19 of ULA (P) Act, arising
out of FIR No.193/2021 of Police Station, Sadder.
