Notification

Srinagar, the 26th July, 2022.

S.O.-352. Whereas, on 25-12-2021, the Police Station, Shopian, received a written docket to the effect that a specific information was received regarding hiding of terrorists in the residential house of one Zeeshan Gowhar S/o Altaf Gowhar R/o Chowgam, Shopian. Subsequently, a Joint Cordon and Search Operation was launched by the Police/Security Forces. During the Search Operation, the hiding terrorists started indiscriminate firing upon the Search Party with their illegal arms/ammunition, with the intention to kill them. The fire was retaliated which triggering an encounter ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 301/2021 under section 307 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, 16,18,19,20 of ULA (P) Act, was

for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful  
Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name:

9. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Zeeshan Gowhar Lone and Mohd. Saleem Mir for the commission of offences punishable under relevant Section of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against each at Para (8) above arising out of FIR No. 301/2021 of Police Station, Shopian.
