Notification

Srinagar, the 28th July, 2022.

S.O.-3546 Whereas, on 10-9-2018, the Police Station, Kakapora received a docket to the effect that on a specific information, a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Naman Railway Crossing Kakapora. During checking 04 persons, while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and apprehended, who were later on, identified as Rameez Raja S/o Gh. Mohd Bhat, Mudasir Ahmad Bhat S/o Gh. Mohd Bhat Rø/o Parigam Pulwama, Shameem Ahmad Mir S/o Assadulla Mir R/o Pahoo, Pulwama and Bilal Ahmad Lone S/o Manzoor Ahmad Lone R/o Lelhar, Kakapora. During their personal search 08 posters of LeT banned outfit were recovered from their possession ; and

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Rameez Raja, Mudasir Ahmad Bhat, Shameem Ahmad Mir and Bilal Ahmad Lone, for the commission of offences punishable under sections 18 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 33/2018 of Police Station, Kakapora.
