Srinagar, the 18th August, 2022.

SO-385.ôôWhereas, on 22-02-2022, the Police Station, Sheeri, received a docket to the effect that some unknown terrorists equipped with illegal arms/ammunition were trying to enter Baramulla Town for carrying out the terrorist activities in order to disturb the peace and tranquility in the area. Subsequently, Joint Nakas were established and

during the Naka checking at Khachardari, Zahanpora, two persons
boarded on a Scooty while seeing the Naka Party, tried to escape but
were chased down on the spot and identified as Imtiyaz Ahmad Barwal
S/o Siraj-ud-Din Barwal and Muneer Ahmad Bania S/o Mehar-Din Bania
Rs/o Khachardari, Zehanpora. During their personal search, the Police
recovered 40 AK Rounds from their possession respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 06/2022 under
Sections 7/27 Arms Act, 13, 18, 20 of ULA (P) Act, was registered
in Police Station, Sheeri and the investigation of the case was taken
up. Subsequently, during the investigation, Sections 23 and 39 of
ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the
place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the
statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of
the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused
viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Barwal, was in contact with his father viz. Siraj-
ud-Din Barwal, who is presently in Pakistan, through the virtual mode
and on his directions procured arms/ammunition from Paranjil near
electric transformer and handed over the same to one Showkat Ahmad
Malik S/o Ab. Kabeer Malik R/o Sangrama, for further handing over
to the terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely Mohd Saleem Parray
S/o Gh. Mohd Parrays R/o Hajin, Bandipora, for carrying out the
terrorists activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the
accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Barwal, Muneer Ahmad Bania and Showkat
Ahmad Malik, were working for the terrorists of TRF outfit and under
a well knit criminal conspiracy were facilitating the terrorist of LeT
banned outfit viz. Mohd Saleem Parray, for transportation of arms/
ammunition from one place to another on the directions of accused viz.
Siraj-uid-Din Barwal, for carrying out the terrorist activities in the
area ; and

6. Whereas, the terrorist namely Mohd Saleem Parray, has been
killed in an encounter and the proceedings under the law would abate
against him ; and

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Barwal, Muneer Ahmad Barwal, Showkat Ahmad Malik and Siraj-ud-Din Barwal, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against each at Para (7) above, arising out of FIR No. 06/2022 of Police Station, Sheeri.
