### Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR

Notification

Srinagar, the 31st August, 2022.

S.O.-415. Whereas, on 15-03-2022, the Police Station, Awantipora, received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received regarding the hiding of some unknown terrorists in the residential house of one Dawood Ahmad Parray S/o Gh. Mohammad Parray R/o Katipora, Chursoo, Awantipora. Subsequently, a Joint Cordon and

Search Operation was launched by the Police/Secuirty Forces and during the search, the hiding terrorists fired indiscriminately upon the Search Party with their illegally acquired arms/ammunition, with the intention to kill them. The fire was retaliated, which triggering an encounter ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 39/2022 under Sections 16, 18, 19, 20, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Awantipora, and the investigation of the case was taken up ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, a dead body was recovered from the encounter site who was later on identified as a terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely, Owais Raja Dar S/o Mohammad Ramzan Dar R/o Subhanpora, Kulgam. During the search arms/ammunition viz. 01 AK-56 Rifle, 03 AK Magazines and 80 Rounds were recovered also from the encounter site ; and

4. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused house owner namely, Dawood Ahmad Parray, was arrested in the case and it was established that he was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit particulary killed terrorist namely Owais Raja Dar, and was providing logistic support to him, besides, under a well kint criminal conspiracy voluntarily harboured the said terrorist in his residential house on the date of encounter, for carrying out the terrorist activities ; and

6. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely, Owais Raja Dar, has been killed in the said encounter with the Security Forces and the proceeding under the law would abate against him ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under

sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown  
against their names :

8. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Dawood Ahmad Parray, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 19 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 39/2022 of Police Station, Awantipora.
