Srinagar, the 19th September, 2022.

S.O.444.ô Whereas, on 08-05-2019, the Police Station, Zainapora, received a reliable information that the terrorists of HM banned outfit namely, Adil Bashir Sheikh S/o Bashir Ahmad R/o Zainapora, Zubair Ahmad Wani S/o Nazir Ahmad, Mir Zeenatul Islam S/o Mohammad Ishaq Mir Rø/o Turkawangam, Shakir Khalil Wagay S/o Mohammad

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 25/2019 under sections 307, 364 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, 16 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Zainapora and investigation of the case was set into motion. During the investigation, one injured viz Irfan Ahmad Lone, succumbed to his injuries. Subsequently, Sections 302, 326, 3/5 ESA and Section 18, 23 and 38 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, one Aijaz Ahmad Naikoo S/o Mohammad Abdullah Naikoo R/o Zainapora, was found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused was arrested and it was found that he was in contact with the above terrorists, who provided a hand grenade to the accused for promoting the terrorist activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz Aijaz Ahmad Naikoo, was workimg as Over Ground Worker (OGWs) for the terrorists of HM banned outfit particulary terrorists namely, Adil Bashir Sheikh, Zubair Ahmad Wani. Mir Zeenatul Islam, Shakir Khalil Wagay, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat, Yawer Mushtaq Dar, Adil Wagay @ Sajoo Magray and Sameer Ahmad and was providing logistic support to them. The accused viz. Aijaj Ahmad Naikoo, under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured a hand grenade from the above terrorists, for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area, besides,

6. Whereas, the accused terrorists namely Adil Bashir Sheikh, Zubair Ahmad Wani, Mir Zeenatul Islam, Shakir Khalil Wagay, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat, Yawer Mushtaq Dar, Adil Wagay @ Sajoo Magray and Sameer Ahmad have been killed in the different encounter with the Security forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of winesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name : $\hat{0}$

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Aijaz Ahmad Naikoo, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 25/2022 of Police Station, Zainapora.
