SO-485.ôôWhereas, on 17-04-2022, the Police Station, Vilgam received a docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Sonmulla Crossing. During the checking, a person while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but was chased down on the spot and identified as Bashir Ahmad Kumar S/o Abdul Rahim Kumar R/o Lilam, Tarathpora. During his personal search, the Police recovered 01 Pistol with Magazine and 13 Rounds from his possession ; and

other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the  
conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above  
accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Bashir Ahmad Kumar, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 28/2022 of Police Station, Vilgam.
