## Notification

Srinagar, the 10th October, 2022.

SO-492.66 Whereas, on 13-05-2019, the Police Station, Gool received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received about the movement of some LeT banned terrorists in Hara, Kalimasta, Gool area. Subsequently, a joint Search Operation was launched and during the search two suspects while seeing the search party tried to

escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Tawheel  
Mohi-ud-Din Dar S/o Gh. Mohi-ud-Din Dar R/o Malipora, Kulgam and  
Showket Ahmad Sheikh S/o Ghulam Nabi Sheikh R/o Charsoo,  
Awantipora. During their personal search, the Police recovered  
01 AK-47 Rifle with Magazine, 30 Rounds and an amount of Rs. 8770/-  
(Indian Currency) from their possession respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 40/2019  
under Sections 7/27 Arms Act, 13, 17, 19 of ULA (P) Act, and  
Sections 120-B, 121 and 122 RPC, was registered in the Police Station,  
Gool and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently,  
during the investigation Section 19 of ULA (P) Act was dropped and  
Section 18 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the  
place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the  
statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of  
the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Tawheel  
Mohi-ud-Din Dar and Showket Ahmad Sheikh, along with two other  
accused identified as Abid Gulzar S/o Gulzar Ahmad Reshi R/o Chursoo,  
Awantipora and Ghulam Nabi Chandail S/o Abdul Rehman Chandail  
R/o Bhimdas, Gool, were found in contact with a terrorist of LeT  
banned outfit namely, Naveed Ahmad Bhat @ Abu Talha S/o Ali Mohd  
Bhat R/o Qaimoh, Kulgam. The accused viz. Tahweel Mohi-ud-Din Dar  
and Showket Ahmad Sheikh, received an amount of Rs. 2.5 lacs from  
the terrorist viz. Naveed Ahmad Bhat @ Abu Talha and procured the  
arms/ammunition from the accused viz. Ghulam Nabi Chandail, after  
handing over an amount of Rs. 2,40,000/- to him. Subsequently, the  
accused viz. Abid Gulzar and Ghulam Nabi Chandail, were also arrested  
in the case ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the  
accused viz. Naveed Ahmad Bhat @ Abu Talha, is member of LeT  
banned outfit and the accused namely Tahweel Mohi-ud-Din Dar,  
Showket Ahmad Sheikh, Abid Gulzar and Ghulam Nabi Chandail, were  
working for the said terrorist and under a well knit criminal conspiracy  
were raising funds for the terrorist for carrying out the terrorist activities

in the area, besides, were conspiring to waging war against the  
Government of India by collecting arms ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and Ranbir Penal Code as shown against their name :ô

7. Whereas, the accused namely Tahweel Mohi-ud-Din Dar and Abid Gulzar, have been found juvenile during the investigation and in view of Section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act ; and

8. Whereas, the accused namely Naveed Ahmad Bhat @ Abu Talha, being the active terrorist is, absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC, have been proposed to be initiated against him ; and

9. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)

documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law ; and

Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused under the aforementioned provision of the Ranbir Penal Code (RPC).

Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and Section 196 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Showket Ahmad Sheikh, Ghulam Nabi Chandail and Naveed Ahmad Bhat @ Abu Talha, for the commission of offences punishable under relevant sections as indicated in para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 40/2019 of Police Station, Gool.
