Srinagar, the 12th October, 2022.

S.O.-508.ô Whereas, on 08-10-2018, Police Station, Khrew received a reliable information that a terrorist of HM banned outfit namely Adil Ahmad Bhat S/o Bilal Ahmad Bhat R/o Malangpora, Pulwama, has handed over an amount of Rs. 10.10 lacs to one OGW namely Rouf-ul-Islam Wani S/o Ab. Aziz Wani R/o Batapora, Khrew,

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 75/2018 under Sections 17, 18, 20, 21, 38, 39, 40 of ULA (P) Act was registered in Police Station, Khrew and the investigation of the case was taken up; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Rouf-ul-Islam Wani, was arrested in the case and it was found that after receiving an amount of Rs. 10.10 lacs from the terrorist viz. Adil Ahmad Bhat, he had distributed an amount of Rs. 6.10 lacs among the OGWs of HM banned outfit identified as Mohammad Maqbool Wani S/o Gh. Qadir Wani R/o Batapora, Ladhoo, Shakeel Ahmad Wani S/o Gh. Mohammad Wani R/o Ladhoo and Musaib Aziz Gojri S/o Ab. Aziz Gojri R/o Namlabal, Pampore. Subsequently, the accused viz. Mohammad Maqbool Wani, Shakeel Ahmad Wani and Musaib Aziz Gojri, were also arrested in the case and an amount of Rs. 6.10 lacs were recovered at their instances respectively. During the investigation, the remaining amount i. e. 04 lacs were also recovered at the instances of accused namely Rouf-ul-Islam Wani; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Rouf-ul-Islam Wani, Mohammad Maqbool Wani, Shakeel Ahmad Wani and Musaib Aziz Gojri, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of HM banned outfit particularly the terrorist namely Adil Ahmad Bhat, and were providing logistic support to them, besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy were knowingly holding the proceeds of terrorism to carry out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, the accused terrorist viz. Adil Ahmad Bhat, has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and

- 7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :ô

- 1. Rouf-ul-Islam Wani S/o Ab. Aziz 18, 21, 39 of Wani R/o Batapora, Ladhoo, Khrew. ULA (P) Act.
- Mohammad Maqbool Wani S/o Gh. Qadir Wani R/o Batpora Ladhoo, Khrew.
- 3. Shakeel Ahmad Wani S/o Gh. Mohammad Wani R/o Ladhoo.
- 4. Musaib Aziz Gojri S/o Ab. Aziz Gojri R/o Namlabal, Pampore.
- 8. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Rouf-ul-Islam Wani, Mohammad Maqbool Wani, Shakeel Ahmad Wani and Musaib Aziz Gojri, for the
