Srinagar, the 12th October, 2022.

S.O.-510.ô Whereas, on 05-05-2022, the Police Station, Baramulla, received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received about the movement of some unknown terrorists in Uskhara area. Subsequently, a Joint Naka was established at Hiltop Crossing, Uskhara During the checking two suspects while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Ashiq

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 79/2022 under Sections 13, 16, 18 of ULA (P) Act, 7/25 Arms Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Baramulla and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation Sections 20, 23 and 38 of the ULA (P) Act were added and Section 16 of the ULA (P) Act was dropped from the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the satatements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Ashiq Hussain Lone and Uzair Amin Ganie, were found in contact with some unknown terrorists of LeT banned outfit including some PaK based terrorists through the social media and on their motivation both the accused joined the LeT banned outfit after procuring arms/ammunition from the terrorists of the said outfit; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Ashiq Hussain Lone and Uzair Amin Ganie, were members of LeT banned outfit and under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition from the terrorists of the LeT banned outfit for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :ô

Ganie R/o Kanthbagh, Baramulla.

- 7. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Ashiq Hussain Lone and Uzair Amin Ganie, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18, 20, 23 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 79/2022 of Police Station, Baramulla.
