#### Notification

Srinagar, the 18th October, 2022.

S.O.-529. Whereas, on 08-05-2020, the Police Station, Chadoora, received a docket to the effect that on reliable information about the movement of some unknown terrorists in the area, a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Kilkadal, Chadoora. During the Naka, Police intercepted a vehicle for checking and during the personal checking of driver and his accomplice, who were identified as Mohammad Lateef Koka S/o Gh. Rasool Koka R/o Zenipora and Younus Manzoor Waza S/o Manzoor Ahmad Waza R/o Wathoor, the Police recovered 20 posters of JeM banned outfit and an amount of Rs. 42000/- from their possession respectively ; and

7. Whereas, the accused namely Younus Manzoor Waza, has been found juvenile during the investigation and in view of Section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detension, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act ; and

8. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevent documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *a prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohammad Lateef Koka, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 71/2020 of Police Station, Chadoora.
