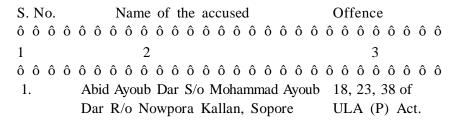

Notification

Srinagar, the 21st October, 2022.

S.O.-546.ô Whereas, on 16-05-2022, the Police Station, Sopore received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received about the movement of some unknown terrorists in Sopore Town. Subsequently, a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Nowpora, crossing. During the checking, two persons while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Abid Ayoub Dar S/o Mohammad Ayoub Dar and Mubashir Manzoor Yatoo S/o Manzoor Ahmad Yatoo Ros/o Nowpora

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 97/2022 under Sections 7/25 Arms Act, 18, 23 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Sopore and the investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation, Section 20 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of place of occurrence and the seizure memos of recovered arms/ammunition were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Abid Ayoub Dar and Mubashir Manzoor Yatoo, were found in contact with a terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely Aadil Ahmad Denthoo S/o Abdul Rehman Denthoo R/o Gulabad, Arampora A/P Kaboo Mohalla, Sopore, who provide the said arms/ammunition to the accused in order to carry terrorist activities in the area; and
- 5. Whereas, during the further investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Aadil Ahmad Denthoo, is member of LeT banned outfit and the other accused viz. Abid Ayoub Dar and Mubashir Manzoor Yatoo, were associated with the said terrorist organization and under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition from the terrorist viz. Aadil Ahmad Denthoo, for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offence punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô



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- 2. Mubashir Manzoor Yatoo S/o Manzoor 18, 23, 38 of Ahmad Yatoo R/o Nowpora Kalgan, ULA(P) Act. Sopore.
- 3. Aadil Ahmad Denthoo S/o Abdul 18, 20 of Rehman Denthoo R/o Gulabad, ULA(P) Act. Armapora A/P Kaboo Mohalla, Sopore.
- 7. Whereas, the accused viz. Aadil Ahmad Denthoo, being the active terrorist is absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. P.C. have been proposed to be initiated against him; and
- 8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 9. Whereas, after persusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Aadil Ahmad Denthoo, Abid Ayoub Dar and Mubashir Manzoor Yatoo, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against each accused at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 97/2022 of Police Station, Sopore.
