## Notification

Srinagar, the 21st October, 2022.

SO-549.66Whereas, on 20-11-2009, the Police Station, Chadoora received a docket from Incharge Police Party on patrolling duty at Aram Mohalla, Chadoora, J&K National Front Chairman namely Nayeem Ahmad Khan was noticed to have entered Jamia Masjid and raised antinational slogans challenging the integrity and sovereignty of the nation, besides, instigating the people to support the Bandh call given by Hurriyat Chairman, Syed Ali Shah Geelani; and

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 207/2009 under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Chadoora and the investigation, of the case was taken up; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of place of the occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that accused Nayeem Ahmad Khan S/o Ghulam Mohd Khan R/o Baghat Barzulla, Srinagar on the directions of accused Syed Ali Shah Geelani S/o Syed Mohammad Shah R/o Sopore had raised the anti-national slogans challenging the integrity and sovereignty of the nation besides instigating the people to support the Pulwama Bandh call; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that on the date of occurrence, the accused viz. Nayeem Ahmad Khan, on the directions of accused viz. Syed Ali Shah Geelani raised anti-national slogans and instigating the mob to raise against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of India; and
- 6. Whereas, the accused viz. Nayeem Ahmad Khan, is presently lodged in Tihar Jail, New Delhi in connection with some other offences, while as accused viz. Syed Ali Shah Geelani, has expired and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against his name :ô

- 8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Nayeem Ahmad Khan for the commission of offence punishable under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 207/2009 of Police Station, Chadoora.
