Srinagar, the 29th October, 2022.

SO-555.ôôWhereas, on 20-08-2016, the Police Station, Pulwama, received a docket to the effect that miscreants of Village Pahoo, Pulwama and adjacent villages led by persons identified as Shabir Ahmad Wani S/o Ali Mohnnnnd Wani R/o Banderpora, Shabir Ahmad Mir @ Badshah S/o Wali Mohnmmad Mir and Shameem Ahmad Mir S/o Assadullah Mir residents of Pahoo, Pulwama, organized an unlawful assembly at Pahoo,

Pulwama and raised anti-national slogans, besides, provoked the general  
public against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Union of  
India ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 352/2016 under  
Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Pulwama  
and investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during  
the investigation, the Section 120-B RPC, was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan  
of the place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and the  
statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of  
the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, four other persons identified  
as Javaid Dar S/o Assadullah Dar, Javaid Ahmad Mir S/o Gh. Mohd  
Mir, Fayaz Ahmad Mir S/o Ab. Rashid Mir Rs/o Pahoo, Kakapora and  
Gh. Mohd Hura S/o Gh. Rasool Hura R/o Gulbugh, Kakapora were  
found involved in the commission of the crime. Subsequently, the accused  
were arrested in the case ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, the person namely, Shabir  
Ahmad Mir @ Badshah, was not found involved in the case. Subsequently,  
the said person was dropped from the case and was given the benefit  
of Section 169 Cr. PC. During the investigation, the actual particulars  
of the accused Shabir Ahmad Wani, were found as Shabir Ahmad Padroo  
S/o Gh. Nabi Padroo R/o Banderpora, Wakherwan, Pulwama ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that on the date  
of occurrence, the accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Padroo, Shameem Ahmad  
Mir, Javaid Ahmad Dar, Javaid Ahmad Mir, Fayaz Ahmad Mir and Gh.  
Mohd Hura, assembled a gathering at Pahoo, Kakapora and delivered  
a speech and raised anti-national slogans against the Government of India,  
besides, instigated the general public against the sovereignty and territorial  
integrity of the Union of India ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence  
collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement  
of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching
