Srinagar, the 29th October, 2022.

SO-558.ôôWhereas, on 04-04-2017, the Police Station, Uri received a docket to the effect that an information was received regarding smuggling of arms/ammunition within the jurisdiction of Police Station, Uri. Subsequently, a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Madiyan, Kamalkote, and during the checking, three persons while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased down on

the spot and identified as Hadaytullah Sheikh S/o Manga Sheikh,  
Mohammad Latief Sheikh S/o Hadaytullah Sheikh and Mohammad Rafiq  
Jinjua S/o Aalam-Din Jinjua Rs/o Madiyan, Kamalkote. During their  
personal search, the Police recovered 04 AK Rifles, 12 AK Magazines  
and 349 Rounds from their possession respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 15/2017 under  
Section 7/25 Arms Act, 120-B RPC, 18 and 18-B of ULA (P) Act,  
was registered in Police Station, Uri and the investigation of the case  
was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the  
Section 18-B of ULA (P) Act was dropped and the Sections 23 and  
39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the  
place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and the statement  
of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case  
were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the  
accused viz. Hadaytullah Sheikh, Mohammad Latief Sheikh and  
Mohamamd Rafiq Jinjua, were working as Over Ground Workers  
(OGWs) for the terrorists and were providing logistic support to them,  
besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy were facilitating the  
transportation of their arms/ammunition from one place to another for  
carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, the accused viz. Hadaytullah Sheikh, has expired and  
the proceedings under the law would abate against him ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence  
collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement  
of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable  
under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown  
against their name :
