### **Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.**

## Notification

Srinagar, the 29th October, 2022.

S.O.-560.ô Whereas, on 31-05-2008, the Police Station, Zainapora received a docket to the effect that Hurriyat activists identified as Syed Ali Shah Geelani S/o Syed Peer Mohammad Geelani R/o Dooru, Sopore A/P Rehmatabad, Hyderpora, Mohammad Yousuf Ganie @ Falahi S/o Gh. Mohammad Ganie R/o Molu, Chitragam, Shakeel Ahmad Itoo S/o Gh. Nabi Itoo R/o Manihal, Shopian and Tariq Amin Shah S/o Mohammad Amin Shah R/o Baba Mohalla, Shopian, assembled a mob in Village Manihal and raised anti-national slogans, provoked the general public against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Union of India ; and



8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohammad Yousuf Ganie @ Falahi, Shakeel Ahmad Itoo and Tariq Amin Shah, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13 of ULA (P) Act, arising out FIR No. 32/2015 of Police Station, Zainapora.
