SO-572.ôôWhereas, on 04-04-2022, a tip-off was received by the Police Station, Pulwama to the effect that some unknown terrorists fired upon two non-local labours identified as Patleshvar Kumar S/o Joko Choudhary and Joko Choudhary S/o Thag Choudhary Rs/o Bihar at Lajoora, Pulwama, with their illegal arms/ammunition, with the intention to kill them, resulting in the injuries to both the persons ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :ô

9. Whereas, the accused viz. Aqib Mushtaq Bhat and Arjumand Gulzar Dar, being the active terrorists are absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC, have been proposed to be initiated against them ; and

10. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching
