## Notification

Jammu, the 11th November, 2022.

S.O.-592.ô Whereas, on 31-07-2022, an information was received by the Police Station, Kakapora, to the effect that two persons identified as Ishaq Hassan Lone S/o Gh. Hassan Lone and Manzoor Ahmad Lone @ Sahaba S/o Gh. Mohd Lone Rs/o Lelhar, Kakapora, were working as

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 60/2022 under Sections 18, 20, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Kakapora and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Section 23 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Ishaq Hassan Lone and Manzoor Ahmad Lone, were arrested in the case and were found in contact with the terrorists of LeT banned outfit namely Riyaz Ahmad Dar @ Sheeraz @ Khalid and Kaiser Rashid Koka S/o Ab. Rashid Koka R/o Kaigam, who provided arms/ammunition to them in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. Subsequently, during the investigation, 01 AK Magazine, 37 AK Rounds and 13 empty AK Rounds were recovered at their instances respectively; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, one more person namely Ishaq Ahmad Lone S/o Gh. Nabi Lone R/o Lelhar, Kakapora, was found in contact with the terrorists of LeT banned outfit viz. Riyaz Ahmad Dar @ Sheraz @ Khalid and Kaiser Rashid Koka, and was facilitating their movement from one place to another. The accused viz. Ishaq Ahmad Lone and terrorist namely Kaiser Rashid Koka, have been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Riyaz Ahmad Dar @ Sheeraz @ Khalid, is a member of LeT banned outfit and the other accused viz. Ishaq Hassan Lone and Manzoor Ahmad Lone @ Sahaba, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit particularly the terrorist viz. Riyaz Ahmad Dar @ Sheeraz @ Khalid, and were providing logistic support to

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô
- - Ishaq Hassan Lone S/o Gh. Hassan
    Lone R/o Lelhar, Kakapora.
    ULA (P) Act.
  - 2. Manzoor Ahmad Lone @ Sahaba S/o Gh. Mohd Lone R/o Lelhar, Kakapora.
  - 3. Riyaz Ahmad Dar @ Sheeraz @ Khalid 18, 20, 38 of S/o Ab. Aziz Dar R/o Sathergund, Kakapora. ULA (P) Act.
- 8. Whereas, the accused viz. Riyaz Ahmad Dar @ Sheeraz @ Khalid, being the active terrorist is absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. P. C. have been proposed to be initiated against him; and
- 9. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution
