SO-612.6 Whereas, on 28-05-2022, an information was received by the Police Station, Parimpora, to the effect that the terrorists of HM/TRF (offshot of LeT) banned outfit identified as Basit Ahmad Dar R/o Redwani, Kulgam, Mohd Latief Rather @ Gazi R/o Badipora, Chadoora, Momin Gulzar Mir R/o Firdous Abad, Eidgah, Saqib Mushtaq Mir R/o Khanmoh, Adil Ahmad Parray @ Hafiz Adil R/o Badergund, Ganderbal and Umais Ahmad Wani @ Khubaib S/o Nisar Ahmad R/o Chawalgam, Kulgam, with the help of their associates, circulating

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Basit Ahmad Dar, Mohd Latief Rather @ Gazi, Momin Gulzar Mir, Saqib Mushtaq Mir, Adil Ahmad Parray, Umais Ahmad Wani @ Khubaib and Shariq Ahmad Wani, were members of TRF/LeT banned outfit and the other accused namely, Mst. Shaheena, Asif Younis, Mudasir Ahmad Mir, Altaf Ahmad Dar, Abdul Rehman Bhat and Zaid Mohammad Rather, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the above terrorist and were providing logistic support to them, besides, the accused viz. Mst. Shaheena, Asif Younis, Mudasir Ahmad Mir, Altaf Ahmad Dar and Abdul Rehman Bhat, were voluntarily harbouring the terrorists in their residential houses for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Adil Ahmad Parray @ Hafiz Adil @ Dujana, Saqib Mushtaq Mir and Mohd Latief Rather @ Gazi, were killed in the different encounters, with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under Section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :óó

9. Whereas, the accused namely Basit Ahmad Dar, Momin Gulzar Mir and Umair Ahmad Wani @ Khubaib, being the active terrorists are absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC. have been proposed to be initiated against them ; and

10. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mst. Shaheena, Asif Younis, Mudasir Ahmad
