Jammu, the 23rd November, 2022.

SO-628.66Whereas, on 15-06-2022, the Police Station, Pampore, received a docket to the effect that a Naka was established at Galandar crossing and during the checking three persons while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Hayat Yousuf Baba S/o Mohammad Yousuf Baba R/o Kuchmulla, Tral, Muzamil Farooq Teeli S/o Farooq Ahmad Teeli R/o Gulshanpora, Tral and Mohammad Ashraf Bhat S/o Bashir Ahmad Bhat R/o

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 69/2022 under Sections 7/25 Arms Act, 13, 18, 23, 38, 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Pampore and the investigation of the case was set into motion; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of place of the occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Hayat Yousuf Baba, Muzamil Farooq Teeli and Mohammad Ashraf Bhat, were found in contact with a terrorist of JeM banned outfit, namely Aijaz Ahmad Bhat S/o Ghulam Mohammad Bhat R/o Teeli Mohalla, Syed Abad, Tral, who provided the ammunition and incriminatory material to the accused with the directions to hand over the same to other two persons namely Aaqib Shafi Gari S/o Mohd Shafi Gari R/o Kadlabal, Pampore and Yasir Javeed Najar S/o Javeed Ahmad Najar R/o Drangbal, Pampore. Subsequently, the accused viz. Aaqib Shafi Gari and Yasir Javeed Najar, were also arrested in the case; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Hayat Yousuf Baba, Muzamil Farooq Teeli Mohammad Ashraf Bhat, Aaqib Shafi Gari and Yasir Javeed Najar, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of JeM banned outfit particularly the terrorist namely Aijaz Ahmad Bhat, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to him, besides, were facilitating the terrorist viz. Aijaz Ahmad Bhat, for transpiration of arms/ammunition from one place to another for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable

- 7. Whereas, the accused viz. Aijaz Ahmad Bhat, being the active terrorist is absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC have been proposed to be initiated against him; and
- 8. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Hayat Yousuf Baba, Muzamil Farooq Teeli, Mohammad Ashraf Bhat, Aaqib Shafi Gari, Yasir Javeed Najar and Aijaz Ahmad Bhat, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against each accused at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 69/2022 of Police Station, Pampore.
