Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

Notification

Jammu, the 10th December, 2022.

SO—671.— Whereas, on 22-06-2022, the Police Station, Bijbehara, received a docket to the effect that a Naka was established at Hassanpora Taweela near Railway Crossing and during the checking three suspects while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Tafazul Ahmad Dar S/o Gulzar Ahmad Dar, Suhail Ahmad Dar S/o Shabir Ahmad Dar residents of Tulkhan, Bijbehara and

Uffed Peerzada S/o Peer Wakeel-ul-Rehman R/o Baba Mohalla, Bijbehara. During their personal search, the Police recovered 20 AK-47 Rounds from their possession respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 104/2022 under sections 7/25 Arms Act, 18 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Bijbehara and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Section 18 of ULA (P) Act was dropped and the Section 23 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of the witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Tafazul Ahmad Dar, Suhail Ahmad Dar and Ufeed Peerzada, were found in contact with the Terrorists of Let banned outfit, who provided the ammunition to the accused in order to promote Terrorist Activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Tafazul Ahmad Dar, Suhail Ahmad Dar and Ufeed Peerzada, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the Terrorist of LeT banned outfit and procured the ammunition from the Terrorists for carrying out the Terrorist Activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of the witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :

7. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Dairy File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accussed for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Tafazul Ahmad Dar, Suhail Ahmad Dar and Ufeed Peerzada, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 104/2002 of Police Station, Bijbehara.
