Notification

Jammu, the 10th December, 2022.

SO-673.—Whereas, on 08-07-2022, the Police Station, Kreeri, received a docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Waripora, Payeen, and during the checking a suspect while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but was chased down on the spot and identified as Mohammad Iqbal Bhat S/o Gulzar Ahmad Bhat R/o Tilgam, Payeen. During his personal search, the Police recovered 01 Pistol with Magazine and 07 Rounds from his possession; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 67/2022 under sections 07/25 Arms Act, 13 and 18 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Kreeri, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Sections 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of the witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accussed viz. Mohd. Iqbal Bhat, was found in contact with two Terrorists of LeT banned outfit namely Abu Zarar and Saifullah residents of Pakistan, through virtual mode, who provided the arms/ammunition to the accused viz. Mohammad Iqbal Bhat, in order to promote Terrorist Activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mohd. Iqbal Bhat, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the Terrorists of LeT banned outfit particularly the Pakistani Terrorists namely Abu Zarar and Saifullah, and was providing Logistic support to them, besides, under a well knit conspiracy procured arms/ammunition from the said Terrorist for carrying out the Terrorist Activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, the Investigation, in respect of Pakistani Terrorists viz. Abu Zararar and Saifullah, shall continue to ascertain their actual identity and bring out their role/involvement in the case ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of the witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Actvities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :

8. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accussed; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Dairy File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned asccused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz.Mohd Iqbal Bhat, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 67/2022 of Police Station, Kreeri.
