Jammu, the 13th December, 2022.

SO-683.66Whereas, on 08-09-2016, an information was received by the Police Station, Pulwama, to the effect that Hurriyat activists/miscreants namely Sheeraz Ahmad Mir S/o Mohd Abdullah Mir R/o Nawnagri, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat S/o Ali Mohd Bhat R/o Naina, Batpora A/P Budgam, Tariq Ahmad Thoker S/o Ab. Ahad Thoker R/o Udoora, Rayees Ahamd Wani S/o Ab. Ahad Wani R/o Batnoor, Sajad Ahmad Bhat @ Hashmi S/o Mohd Abdullah Bhat R/o Rajpora, Aijaz Ahmad Wani @ Jaja S/o Bashir Ahmad Wani R/o Batnoor, Sonaullah Mir S/o Gh. Mohd Mir R/o Nowpora, Payeen and Shahnawaz Gazali R/o Anantnag, addressed a gathering at Village Batnoor and delivered a provocative speech against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Union of India; and

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 387/2016 under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Pulwama and the investigation of the case was set into motion; and
- 3. Whereas, during, the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Sheeraz Ahmad Mir, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat, Tariq Ahmad Thoker, Rayees Ahamd Wani, Sajad Ahmad Bhat @ Hashmi, Aijaz Ahmad Wani @ Jaja and Sonaullah Mir, were arrested in the case and the actual particulars of accused viz. Shahnawaz Gazali, were not ascertained and subsequently, his name was dropped from the case. During investigation, two more persons namely Rameez Ahmad Mir S/o Mohd Ahsan Mir R/o Rajpora and Asif Ali Dar S/o Ali Mohd Dar R/o Niloora, were found involved in the commission of crime and were also arrested in the case; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that on the date of occurrence the accused viz. Sheeraz Ahmad Mir, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat, Tariq Ahmad Thoker, Rayees Ahamd Wani, Sajad Ahmad Bhat Hashmi, Aijaz Ahmad Wani @ Jaja, Sonaullah Mir, Rameez Ahmad Mir and Asif Ali Dar, upon a Batnoor Chalo call given by the Hurriyat leaders, delivered a provocative speech and raised anti-national slogans, besides, instigated the general public against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Union of India; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :ô

- 7. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)
