SO-685.ôôWhereas, on 20-08-2021, the Police Station, Khrew, received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received about the presence of some unknown terrorists in the residential house of one Gh. Ahmad Najar S/o Gh. Mohd Najar R/o Dhanak Mohalla, Khrew. Subsequently, a Joint Cordon and Search Operation was launched by the Police/Security Forces in the area. During the search, the hiding terrorists fired indiscriminately upon the Search Party with their illegal arms/ammunition, with the intention to kill them. The fire was retaliated by the Police/Security Forces, triggering an encounter ; and

Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :ô

9. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Nizam-u-Din Najar, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 19 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 57/2021 of Police Station, Khrew.
