## Notification

Jammu, the 13th December, 2022.

SO-686.66Whereas, on 15-09-2022, the Police Station, Magam, received a docket to the effect that during patrolling duty at Playground, Narbal, a suspect while seeing the Police Party tried to escape but was chased down on the spot and identified as Nazir Ahmad Bhat S/o Habibullah Bhat R/o Sheikh Mohalla, Narbal, Budgam. During his personal search, the Police recovered 10 posters of LeT banned outfit from his possession; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 146/2022 under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Magam and the investigation of the case was set into motion; and

- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Nazir Ahmad Bhat, procured the posters of LeT banned outfit from an unknown person for carrying out the unlawful activities in the area; and
- 5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :ô

- 6. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching
