SO-716.ôôWhereas, on 12-11-2019, a reliable information was received by the Police Station, D. H. Pora, to the effect that a group of OGWs working for HM banned outfit identified as Lateef Ahmad Ahanger S/o Ghulam Ahmad Ahanger R/o D. K. Marag, Mohd Ashraf Malik S/o Bashir Ahmad Malik R/o Khull, Ahmadabad, Shahzad Ahmad Wani S/o Habibullah Wani R/o Shalipora, Katrasoo, Sajad Ahamd Naik S/o Ab. Rashid Naik R/o Rakhama, Shopian and Ishfaq Ahmad Sheikh

S/o Mushtaq Ahmad Sheikh R/o Katrasoo, Kulgam, were arranging  
weapons for the terrorists of the outfit namely Sheeraz Ahmad Lone  
@ Molvi R/o Souch, Shahid Sadiq Malik R/o Kull, Ahmadabad and Aijaz  
Ahmad Naik R/o Chimmer, and motivating youth of the area to join  
the outfit, besides, harbouring the terrorists, who provided 02 AK-47  
Rifles to the accused OGWs for their recruitment in order to promote  
terrorist activities in the area ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 98/2019 under  
Sections 13 (2), 18, 19, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered  
in the Police Station, D. H. Pora, and the investigation of the case was  
set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Section 20  
of ULA (P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Lateef Ahmad  
Ahanger, Mohd Ashraf Malik, Shahzad Ahmad Wani, Sajad Ahmad Naik  
and Ishfaq Ahmad Sheikh, were arrested in contact with the terrorists  
of the HM banned outfit namely Sheeraz Ahmad Lone @ Movli, Shahid  
Sadiq Malik and Aijaz Ahmad Naik ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the seizure memos were  
prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and  
circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions  
of law ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the  
accused viz. Lateef Ahmad Ahanger, Mohd Ashraf Malik, Shahzad Ahmad  
Wani, Sajad Ahmad Naik and Ishfaq Ahmad Sheikh, were working as  
Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of the HM banned  
outfit particularly the terrorists namely Sheeraz Ahmad Lone @ Movli,  
Shahid Sadiq Malik and Aijaz Ahmad Naik, and under a well knit criminal  
conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, were  
voluntarily harbouring the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities  
in the area ; and

6. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely, Sheeraz Ahmad Lone  
@ Movli, Shahid Sadiq Malik and Aijaz Ahmad Naik, have been killed  
in the different encounters with the Security Forces and the proceedings  
under the law would abate against them ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of  
witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer,  
has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned

accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of

8. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Lateef Ahmad Ahanger, Mohd Ashraf Malik, Shahzad Ahmad Wani, Sajad Ahmad Naik and Ishfaq Ahmad Sheikh, for the commission of offences punishable under
