Notification

Jammu, the 24th February, 2022.

S.O.-77.ô Whereas, on 31-8-2021, Pulwama Police during naka checking at Lonepora Zadoora intercepted a person for checking who tried to escape but was chased down on spot and indentified as Suraj Ahmad Dar S/o Fayaz Ahmad R/o Gusoo Pulwama. During checking of bag being carried by the said person, Police recovered 08 AK-47 rounds from his bag; and

- 2. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 241/2021 under Sections 7/25 Arms Act,/16, 18, 20, ULA (P) Act was registered in Police Station Pulwama and investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during investigation Sections 16, 20 ULA (P) Act were dropped and Sections 23, 39 ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memo were prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused person Suraj Ahmad Dar was working as over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit and was facilitating the transportation of arms/ ammunition to the terrorists from one place to another for carrying out the terrorists activities in the area; and
- 5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused person for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against his name of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :ô

- 6. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused person; and
- 7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused persons for their prosecution under the provisions of law.
