## Notification

Jammu, the 24th February, 2022.

S.O.-80.ô Whereas, on 18-06-2021, Baramulla Police during joint naka checking at Bandi Uri Intercepted a vehicle for checking. The driver alongwith two persons tried to escape but were chased down on spot who were later identified as Sajad Anzar Shah S/o Mohammad Anzar R/o Lalpora Lolab, Sharafat Khan S/o Lal Badshah R/o Keran and Shahid Hussain S/o Wali Mohammad Rather R/o Khaipora,

- 2. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 63/2021 under sections 7/25 Arms Act 8/21, 29 NDPS Act, 18, 23 Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 came to be registered in Police Station, Uri and investigation of the case was set into motion. During investigation sections 17, 39 ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provision of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, seven other accused persons namely (1) Reyaz Ahmad Hajam S/o Ali Hajam R/o Yarikh, Chadoora Budgam, (2) Adil Bashir S/o Bashir Ahmad R/o Nemtha, Chadoora, (3) Faiz Ahmad Khan S/o Mohammad Ashraf R/o Keran, (4) Angraz Singh S/o Harjeet Singh R/o Chaharpur Amratsar, (5) Raman S/o Prem R/o Housing Board Colony, Ferozpur, Punjab, (6) Rohit S/o Gopal Chand, (7) Kishan S/o Vijay Kumar Rø S/o Bastiya Border Road, Ferozepur, were found involved in the case; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation, all the above seven accused persons were arrested in connection with the case and during questioning 02 Chinese Pistols, 02 Pistol Magazines, 10 Pistol rounds, 05 Chinese hand grenades, 06 Packets of contraband, two cheques of Rs. 50,000/- each and cash to the tune of Rs. 19,50,000/- were recovered from their possession. The arms/ammunition and cash of Rs. 19,50,000/- were provided to them by accused Sajid Anzar for further distribution among the terrorists of LeT outfit active in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused Sajad Anzar was in constant touch with a PoK based terrorist Mir Mushtaq through social media and he alongwith accused Sharafat Khan, Shahid Hussain, and Faiz Khan procured arms/ammunition, contraband (Heroin) and cash of Indian currency from the said PoK terrorist near LOC in Uri and handed over some arms//ammunition and

- 7. Whereas, it was also established that the accused Sajid Anzar, Sharafat Khan, Shahid Hussin, Rayaz, Ahmad, Adil Bashir and Faiz Khan were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the LeT terrorists and were providing support to them for carrying out the terrorists activities, besides accused persons Angraz Singh, Raman, Rohit and Kishan under well knit criminal conspiracy obtained contraband (Heroin) from the accused to facilitate raising of funds through narcotic deals and sale of contraband for utilization of funds for strengthening the LeT cadre in the valley; and
- 8. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the investigating officer has *prima facie* estblished involvement of the below mentioned accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under section(s) as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô

Whereas, accused namely Kishan S/o Vijay Kumar has been found Juvenile during the investigation and in view of Section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act; and
- 10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused persons; and
- 11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused Sajad Anzar, Sharafat Khan, Shahid Hussain, Reyaz Ahmad, Aadil Bashir, Faiz Khan, Angraj Singh, Raman and
